In-Depth Inspections by Qualified Staff

Textile Pest Monitors

Rentokil use a range of Textile Pest monitors, including those for the Common Clothes moth and Varied Carpet Beetle, in order to identify, and treat, infestations before they damage your textile items.

PestNetOnline Reporting

All inspected areas, and infestations, can be comprehensively recorded using Rentokil's online reporting system, PestNetOnline.

Rentokil Heat Pod

Rentokil Heat treatments work by heating up insect items to between 55°C to 60°C. At these temperatures all stages of an insects life cycle, from egg to adult, will die within an hour.

Insecticide Spray Treatments

Rentokil use targeted, pH neutral, insecticide spray treatments to quickly reduce Textile Pest populations within infested areas.

Controlled Atmosphere Technology (C.A.T)

Rentokil's Controlled Atmosphere Technology uses inert gases to control all life cycle stages of insects. Two treatment options are available: anoxic treatments, using nitrogen to reduce the oxygen level to below 0.2% or carbon dioxide at concentrations above 60%.
